

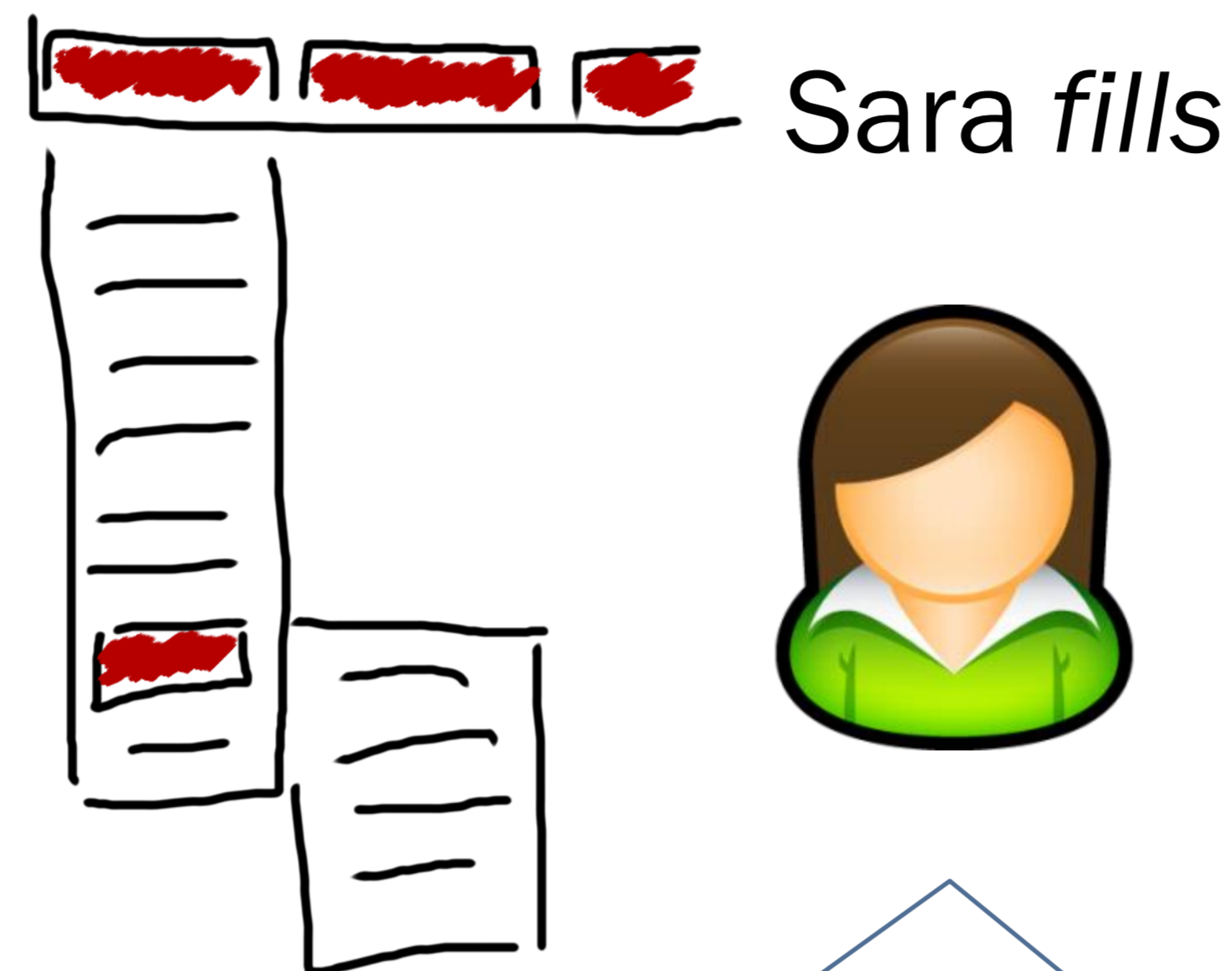
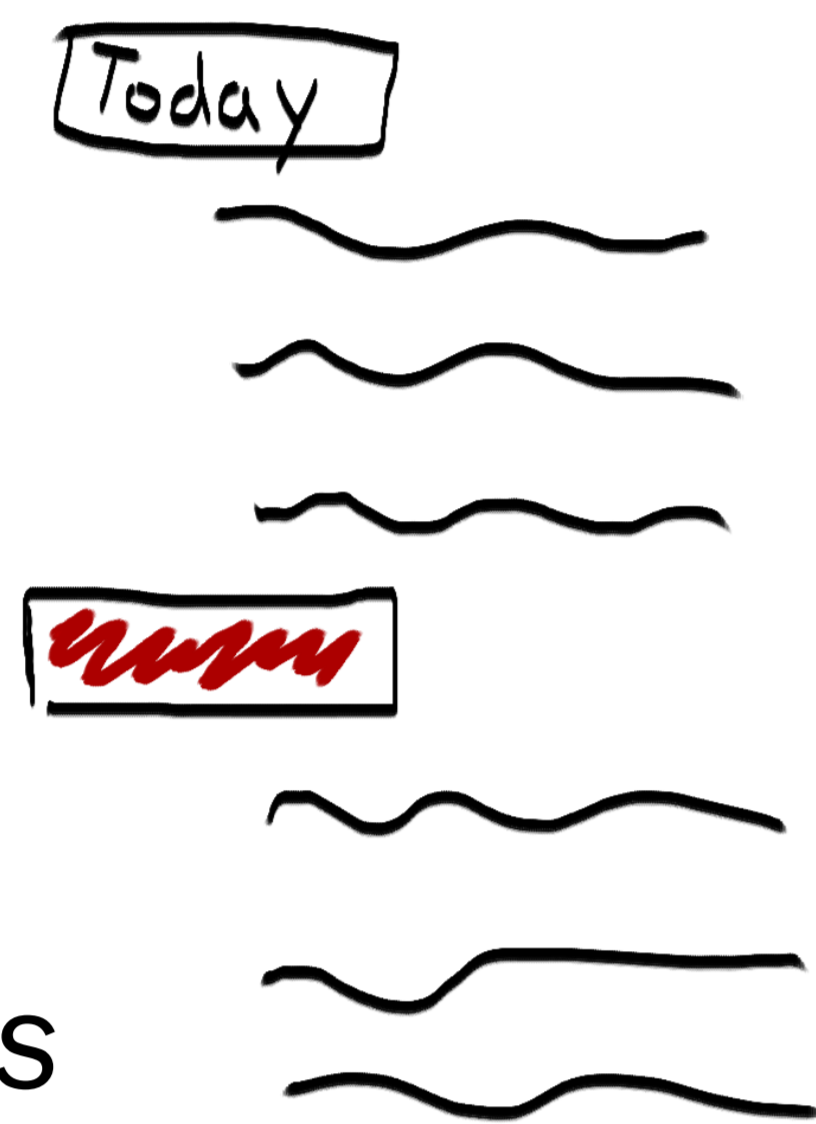
Motivation

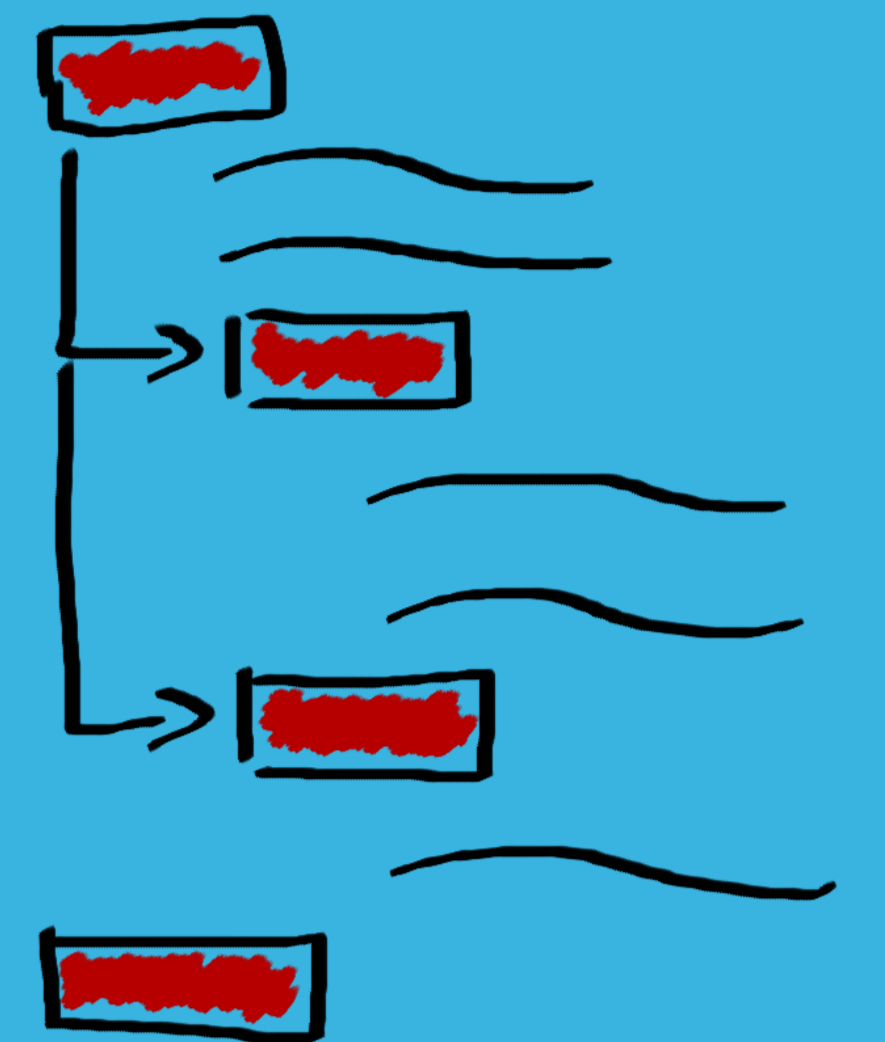
I fill in new documents as they come to places where I feel they belong. Though finding them is another story. I have settled with browsers bookmarks to organize my favorites.

Method

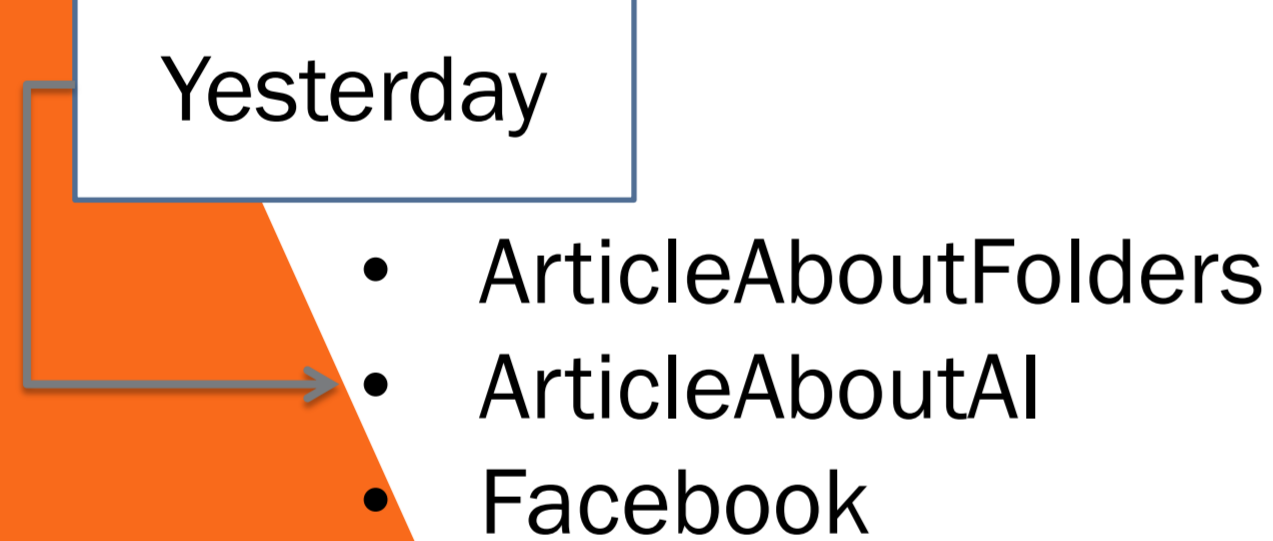
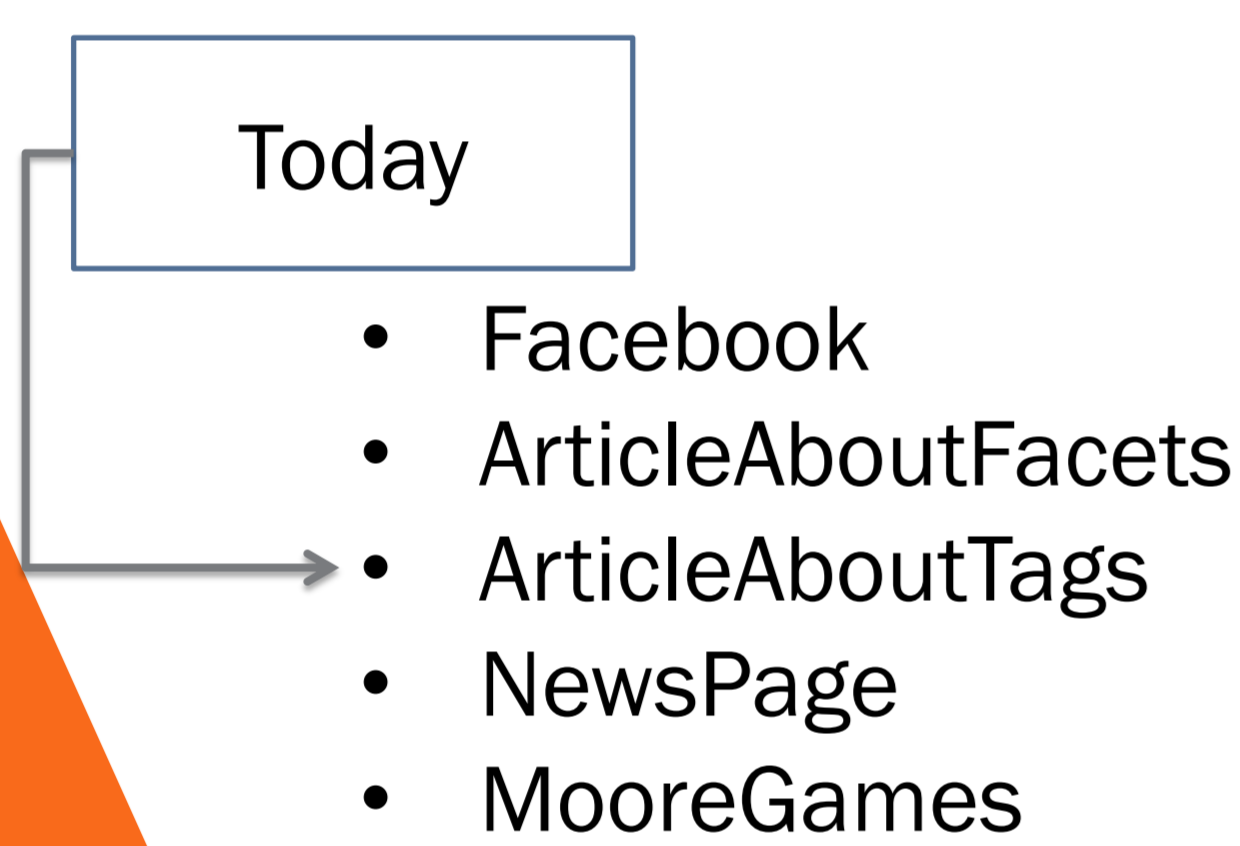
- Facet tree – employed for organizing documents by chaining relevant facets to generate desired groupings and hierarchy of resources.
- Specify filter values for each facet to search or to generate only the relevant part of the whole personal organization structure.

Available facets:

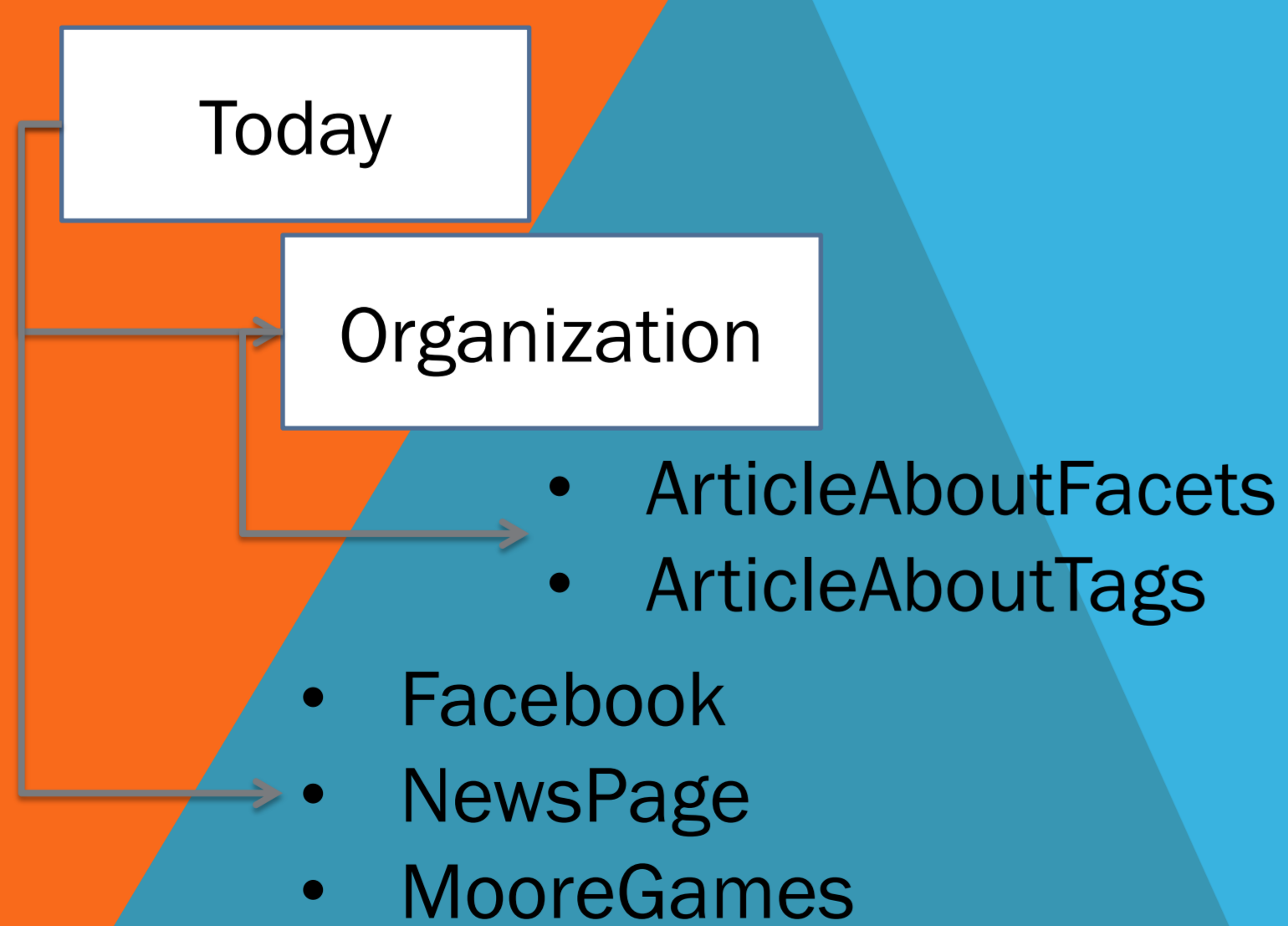
- Type (article, web page)
