MISSION AND OBJECTIVES

As malt, hops and water are the main ingredients of every beer, so relentless pursuit of Beer-Driven Research (BDR), dissemination of knowledge and beernovation are main objectives of Academia SeBeana, which was established previous academic year.

We focus on modern research trends related to the so-called Beer Data, characterized by 4 Vs: Volume, Variability (of brands), Velocity (of drinking) and Veracity (of samples), processing of potentially infinite beer streams (by utilizing well-known Brewier transformation¹) as well as qualitative analysis of beer savouring by means of (doubled-) gaze tracking.

Overall, our mission is to raise a new generation of young beertelligence able to pursue the Holy Grail of beer science – finding the creative and productive peak in BDR: the SeBe peak.

 - Bottling systems
